## Laura Lee – Answering Questions and Recapping Small Group Discussions From HCC's Coalition Meeting in June

- Does HCC have a social media page/website?
  - a. www.healthycommunitycollab.org
- What does HCC "want"/what is the ask?
  - a. At this time, the main ask/invitation that HCC has for people is to contribute their perspectives and ideas so that together we can create a more-full picture of what our "Want/Ask" can and will be
- Does HCC have flyers/brochures that can be handed out at community events?
  - a. We have "Connection Cards" in both English and Spanish
- How does HCC interconnect with other community organizations (for example, Safety Net)?
  - a. We don't have an answer for this yet; Room to discover answers to this
- What resources could HCC put on a resource table at an outreach event/do we have "swag"?
  - a. As of now, the only HCC outreach item available are the English and Spanish Connection Cards
- Is there an event tab on the HCC website?
  - a. Yes
- Who are all of the organizations that are participating in HCC?
  - a. At our coalition meeting in June, there were 25 people who have connections to 18 different organizations present; at the time, HCC had about 10 Steering Committee Members; 3 SCMs were present during that meeting
  - a. Within the Steering Committee, there are 13 people who are connected to 13 different organizations
- Outreach events at the forefront tabling at events?

- Can we sponsor events, meet & greets (how can we get individuals here not in this organization?)
  - Events page on the HCC website, invitation to have other organizations send in events that they thing should be on the event page
- Consistency

- Specific churches or alliances with faith based organizations that HCC can be engaged with
- Celebration! no agenda, just celebration HCC shouldn't always be a transactional relationship with the community
- Inviting new members, bringing someone with you to attend HCC meetings and events and contribute their perspectives and ideas to create a fuller picture of what the HCC is
